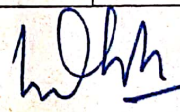
Intended Outcome of Skill Development: To identify the skills required to respond to a given situation; and To sharpen the requisite skills and internalize the same

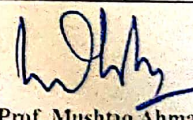
